Elastodontics is a minimally invasive orthodontic and myofunctional therapy that uses removable appliances to guide craniofacial development and correct malocclusions in growing patients. Orofacial muscle dysfunction such as improper swallowing, breathing, and chewing—can negatively impact speech, occlusion, and skeletal growth. AMCOP bioactivators apply gentle, continuous forces to promote balanced development of the muscles, bones, and teeth. For optimal results, these appliances should be combined with myofunctional therapy to support proper muscle balance, physiological swallowing, and nasal breathing—encouraging harmonious growth and long-term stability. This two day course is designed for dental professionals eager to incorporate Elastodontics and Myofunctional therapy into their practice.
